## **LRGC Members & Non-Member Guests: Revised Rules for the Indoor Range**

**With the increase in available shooting positions on the indoor range due to removal of BC Health restrictions, we can currently allow our members to bring non-member guests (i.e. relatives and friends) to shoot on the indoor range.**

**The following rules will apply:**

- 1) Non-member sponsored guests are allowed to attend only on Saturdays (due to RO availability and payment required at the office). This also allows the most time for subsequent shooting.**
- 2) Members may bring up to two non-member guests, and the member must register them into an available New Shooter Orientation (NSO) Session on the desired Saturday morning they plan to shoot, which they must complete/pass before being allowed to shoot. Note: This is a club rule for ALL new indoor range shooters - NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**(Note: Go to the LRGc website calendar and click on the date to see available NSO sessions. Follow all procedures in the description).**

- 3) The sponsoring LRGc member must also attend this session with their guest(s). A one-time fee of \$10.00 will be charged per non-member guest for the NSO session (payable at the LRGc office - no charge for a member). A card will be issued to the guest upon completion of the NSO session for later use and must be presented to the range officer (RO) on duty upon sign-in each time they attend.**

- 4) The guest will be able to attend subsequent Saturdays only where sessions are labelled (Guests Allowed) on the calendar. At**

***present, guests will not be allowed to attend any other shooting sessions due to logistical reasons.***

***5) Non-member daily shoot fees are \$8.00 per session + \$20.00 day pass fee = \$28.00, also payable at the LRGC office (this is in addition to the \$10.00 NSO session fee). Note: Members may not use member-only benefit shoot cards to pay for non-member guests.***

***6) Members are responsible for the actions of their guests, so please consider this before bringing them to the range. The RO will have full discretionary power as to whether the guest is allowed to shoot and/or remain in the range.***

***7) All attendees MUST adhere to club range and safety rules, as well as any BC Health COVID risk prevention rules, which may change at any time and dramatically affect the club's ability to offer continued attendance by non-member guests. While we are hopeful to be able to do so, the LRGC offers no guarantees this ability will continue to exist in the future.***
