

# Urgent! Action Needed!

Dear Langley Rod & Gun Club Member,

The Liberal Party has announced that, if elected, they will BAN semi-auto firearms and allow municipalities to ban handguns. YOU should be actively doing something to prevent this from happening before it is too late. The Liberals must not win the election if we are to retain our firearms and rights to own legally-acquired property.

The most effective way to fight back is by voting on Oct. 21<sup>st</sup> for a candidate or party who will support law-abiding firearms owners' rights. The best action you can take in the meantime is to support those organizations (i.e. CSSA, CCFR, NFA) currently on the frontlines, who are working hard to maintain your rights as a licensed firearm owner, and to make the public aware that such "bans" will not solve the violence problem in Canada.

If you are NOT yet a member of these three groups – you need to get on-board and join them NOW! All are doing important public relations work to protect our firearm rights!

If you join (as a new member) any or all of these groups as a new member between now and Oct 21 (i.e. by Election Day), the LRGC will add a donation of \$10 per membership to that organization. Most do not have a proper understanding of the firearm regulations in Canada and don't take the time to learn or report the true facts.

6) Contact your local municipal leaders and educate them on the lack of common sense of the current proposals.

Don't wait until it is too late - and don't expect others to fight for you if you are unwilling to support them. PLEASE HELP BY DOING YOUR PART!
